



Reception (Ages 4-5)

Learning objectives

The children will learn:

- What an emergency service is
- Who works for the London Ambulance Service and we do
- How you get in touch with the ambulance service
- How to call for help – who is a safe person to ask for help

Pre-learning:

- What is my home address?
- What is my mum or dad's name?

Activities:

Dialing 999

- Use toy phones and get the children to show you how to make a call to the emergency services. The children could role play with you. You could be the call taker and they could be ringing for help.
- Encourage them to learn their address and know their family's names.
- Explain that if an adult/teacher is present they can call 999 for them.

Dress up/Role play

- This activity teaches children how to recognise someone who can help them.
- Children can dress up as a paramedic and an injured person
